




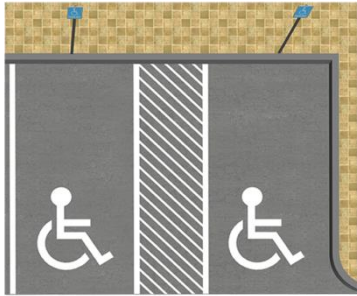
# KOMEDIA

## Travel Guide

	<p><b>By Train</b> Brighton mainline station is approx. 7 minutes away.</p> <p>Last train to London leaves Brighton 23:37, arrives London Victoria 01:09.</p>
	<p><b>By Taxi</b> Taxis can drop you off outside the venue on Gardner Street. The nearest taxi ranks are: East Street and on the corner of North Street &amp; New Road (by the post box).</p> <p>There is a Freephone in the Komedia Café to arrange pick-up from the venue.</p> <p>Local taxi companies: Brighton &amp; Hove City Cabs – 01273 205205 Brighton &amp; Hove Streamline Ltd – 01273 747474</p>
	<p><b>By Car</b> There are several car parks nearby. 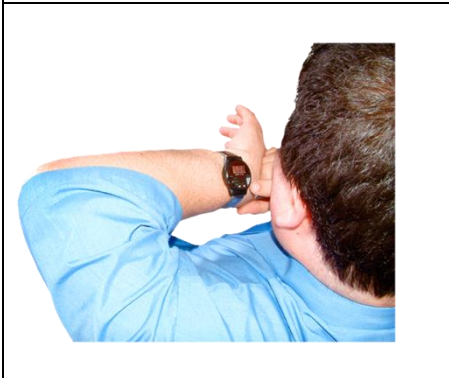

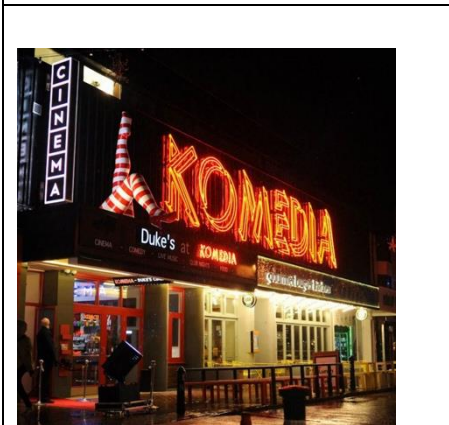


**Disabled (Blue Badge) Parking**  
Blue badge holders may park behind Komedia on Regent Street (postcode BN1 1UL) with a badge for up to three hours on a double yellow line. Komedia's entrance is on Gardner Street so customers will need to make their way from the end of Regent Street and to the entrance in Gardner Street.

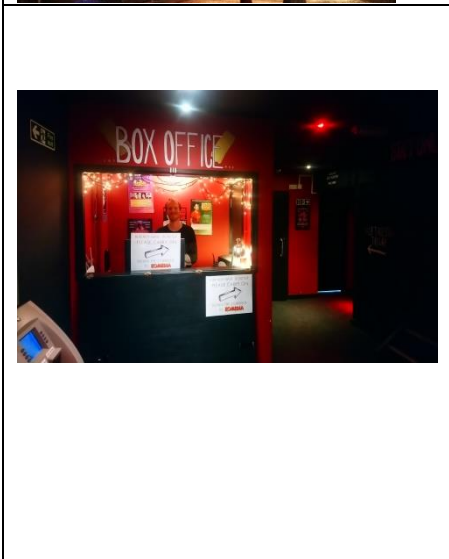

The café is always open from 10am 7 days a week.







**Arriving at the venue**  
The entrance to the venue is through the doors at the back of the café. Any member of security or café staff will be able to assist you if you're not sure where to go.  
  
If early entrance to the venue is required please may we ask you to contact [admin@komedia.co.uk](mailto:admin@komedia.co.uk) so we can make suitable arrangements ahead of your visit.



**Ticket collection**  
After you've gone through the café the ticket office is just to your left by the stairs.  
  
You can buy tickets on the door (if it's not sold out).  
You can also buy tickets for future events here.  
  
If you already have tickets please go past the box office and follow the corridor round the corner. Here you will meet a member of our door team. You can show a print off of your tickets or your email on a smart phone.

	<p>They will then tick your name off the list and direct you through to the right venue room.</p>
	<p><b>Access to the specific venue rooms</b>          Komedia's main entrance is ground level on Gardner Street.</p> <p>Komedia has two performance spaces, Komedia Downstairs and Komedia Studio.</p> <p>Both spaces are accessible by stairs and our lift.</p>
	<p><b>Events in Komedia Studio</b>          The Studio is located on level 1 down one flight of stairs (9 steps), and also by the lift "level 1".</p> <p>The toilets are located back on level 2 which is the same level as the main entrance to Komedia.</p>
	<p><b>Events in the Komedia Downstairs</b>          There are two flights of stairs (18 steps) to the basement venue room and also by the lift.</p> <p>The toilets are located to the left-hand side of the room when looking at the stage.</p>
	<p><b>Leaving the Venue</b>          When leaving the venue please use lift or stairs back to the main entrance on Gardner Street.</p> <p>Click <a href="#">here</a> for an interactive 3D Map of Komedia Brighton.</p> <p><i>Staff will be happy to assist you if required.</i></p>

### **Medical Requirements**

If any medication or essential food and drink are required at our events, we are happy to help. Just let us know so we can tell our staff team working on the night.

If this isn't our possible and staff have been made aware that we are happy for customer's own food to be brought in to the venue when it's important for someone's health.



### **Strobe Lighting Policy**

Strobe Lighting may be used for live music events and club nights.

If we are told in advance that a customer is attending who may be affected by the use of strobes, we won't use them.

Sometimes the artist won't allow us to change this.

If heavy strobe lighting is being used warning signs will be placed around the venue.



### **Sound Levels**

Some gigs are meant to be loud but they should also be safe.

Komedia operates a Noise at Work policy from the current Health and Safety Executive (HSE) guidelines. For this reason we keep a close eye on decibel levels and we also have ear plugs behind the bar for every event.

#### **Toilets**

There are fully accessible disabled toilets for Komedia downstairs and for the Studio.
