

## **Komedia Bath**

### **Deputy Technical Manager - Job Description**

**Reporting to** - General Manager and Technical Manager for Komedia Bath.

**Hours of work** - 40 hours per week, flexible, including evenings, weekends and bank holidays depending on event requirements.

**Salary** - £26,000 per annum.

#### **Context**

Komedia Bath is dedicated solely to live entertainment. Hosting over 400 events a year with two flexible, well-equipped spaces for audiences between 100-788. Originally privately owned, Komedia Bath converted to a Community Benefit Society in March 2019 and is an integral link in the chain of mid-scale venues, providing opportunities for music, cabaret, comedy and other national tours.

#### **Overview**

This is a new, exciting and diverse role that would suit a multi-skilled technician who wants to enhance their skills whilst working in a fun but extremely professional environment. Despite the unrelenting pace of the industry, we strongly believe in a positive work / life balance and every staff member is given the opportunity to grow and develop.

Reporting to the Technical Manager, the Deputy Technical Manager will operate and maintain specialist equipment, whilst observing the highest standards of health and safety. Duties will include rigging, programming, and operating lighting, sound and video equipment, assisting the Technical Manager with pre-production preparations, and supervising visiting technicians.

#### **Key Responsibilities**

The primary function of this role is to provide technical support to incoming and in-house productions, which will include duties such as:

- Rigging, programming and operation of in-house and toured lighting, sound, and A/V equipment;
- Liaising with in-house and touring personnel to ensure the smooth and professional delivery of events;
- Assisting the Technical Manager with pre-production planning;
- Maintaining and testing in-house technical equipment on a regular basis; - Loading and unloading of equipment from touring vehicles;
- Working at height;
- Working with a team and alone;
- Adhering strictly to health and safety procedures and risk assessments; - Any other duties as necessary.

## **General Responsibilities**

- Promote Komedia Bath in a positive and professional manner at all times and display a flexible “can do” approach which will enhance Komedia Bath’s wider reputation;
- Undertake any training necessary to meet the requirements of the post;
- Adopt a flexible approach to working hours as required by the business;
- Undertake any other duties, relevant to the post holder’s skills, which may, from time to time be deemed necessary;
- Be open to new ideas, understand the need for change and be willing to adapt;
- Be aware of the issues of equality and diversity, understand and be sensitive to cultural differences;
- Take all possible steps to ensure a safe working environment for self and others.

## **Essential**

- Minimum of two years experience working as a technician
- Ability to work to a high standard of technical production;
- Demonstrable knowledge and understanding of professional sound systems and digital audio mixing consoles;
- Demonstrable knowledge and understanding of professional theatrical lighting systems and control hardware;
- Demonstrable knowledge and understanding of theatrical rigging systems; - Basic knowledge of professional audio/visual systems;
- Professional and diplomatic approach to customer service;
- Comfortable working at height;
- Ability to follow safe working practices;
- Ability to work alone, within a team, and in a supervising capacity;
- Flexibility to work irregular and unsociable hours (evenings/weekends/public holidays).

## **Desirable**

- Experience operating Midas Pro-series and M-series audio mixing consoles;
- Experience and knowledge of rigging, programming and operating L’Acoustics sound systems;
- Experience programming and operating Avolites and ChamSys lighting consoles; - Experience using motorised and manual chain hoists;
- Experience programming and operating QLab software;
- Experience using Apple macOS-based computers;
- Experience using Blackmagic Design video and media equipment;
- Experience testing and maintaining lighting, sound, and a/v equipment;
- Proficient using Google Apps and Microsoft Office products;
- Industry-relevant qualifications;
- First aid at work qualifications.
